Membership report

We have 2 new members for a total of 245, exactly the same number as of this time last year.

To date Roy has sent out a total of 426 membership packages for a total of 25 new members.

Tech Committee

On Oct 17 two new antennae and feedlines were installed at the top of the tank at the 146.88 site. The new Diamond antenna was installed at and connected to the existing hardline. The old antenna was moved over about six feet and connected to new coaxial cable and a Discone antenna was installed further around the tank to new coaxial cable for use as a receive only antenna for testing purposes.

Bruce Crabill N3ZUY has gone to 103 sites around the area and produced a polar plot of signal strength from the old antenna. He will repeat this process from fewer points to produce a comparison polar plot of signal strength from the new Diamond antenna vis-a-vis the old antenna. Bruce generously donated both new antennae and the feedlines for both to GMRA.

Old Business

Roy has met with Enrique, the banquet manager at Knights of Columbus with regard to our Dec 1 Annual Meeting and Luncheon. The cost this year will be up one dollar from last year to \$21.00 including tax but not gratuity. The menu will be the same as last year. So far Roy has arranged for 52 door prizes for the meeting with a bit of his budget left for a few more.
